Each person must have a funding source to pay the fees for services. If an applicant does not already have funding, South Dakota Achieve may assist in locating and / or applying for funds.

South Dakota Achieve may offer guidance in selecting services, which will support the attainment of personal goals. If appropriate services are not available at South Dakota Achieve, accommodations may be made to provide the services or a referral made to a more appropriate service provider.
